**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF BEVERLY
MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF OHIO
DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORTATION TO MAKE IMPROVEMENTS TO
VARIOUS INTERSECTIONS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BEVERLY.**

*The following is Resolution #21-03, enacted by the Council of the Village of Beverly,
Washington County, Ohio, in regular session on the 12th day of May, 2021.*

SECTION I – Project Description

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Beverly, Ohio, has identified the need for the following described project:

Safety intersection improvement project at four (4) locations on State Route 60 in the Village of Beverly. At SR 60 and Ferry Street work includes a signal replacement. at SR 60 and Center Street work includes signal removal and pedestrian crosswalk improvement. At SR 60 and McIntosh Street work includes installation of pedestrian activated signs. At SR 60 and Ullman Street work includes installation of pedestrian activated signs.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Beverly, County of Washington, State of Ohio, as follows:

SECTION II – Consent Statement

Being in the public interest, the Village of Beverly gives consent to the Director of Transportation to complete the above described project.

SECTION III – Cooperation Statement

The Village of Beverly shall cooperate with the Director of Transportation in the above described project as follows:

The State shall assume and bear 100% of all of the costs of the improvement.

The Village of Beverly agrees to pay 100% of the cost of those features requested by the Village of Beverly which are determined by the State and Federal Highway Administration to be unnecessary for the Project.

SECTION IV – Utilities and Right-of-Way Statement

The Village of Beverly agrees that all right-of-ways required for the described project will be acquired and/or made available in accordance with current State and Federal regulations. The Village of Beverly also understands that right-of-way costs include eligible utility costs.

The Village of Beverly agrees that all utility accommodation, relocation, and reimbursement will comply with the current provisions of 23 CFR 645 and the ODOT Utilities Manual.

SECTION V - Maintenance

Upon completion of the project, and unless otherwise agreed, the Village of Beverly shall: (1) provide adequate maintenance for the project in accordance with all applicable state and federal law, including, but not limited to, Title 23, U.S.C., Section 116; (2) provide ample financial provisions, as necessary, for such maintenance of the project; (3) maintain the right-of-way, keeping it free of obstructions; and (4) hold said right-of-way inviolate for public highway purposes.

SECTION VI – Authority to Sign

The Mayor of said Village of Beverly is hereby empowered on behalf of the Village of Beverly to enter into contracts with the Director of Transportation necessary to complete the above described project.

SECTION VII – Declaration of Emergency

An emergency exists affecting the public health, safety, and general welfare of the citizens of the Village of Beverly, and for further specific reasons, to expedite Resolution #21-03 highway project and to promote highway safety. This Resolution shall take effect and be in force immediately upon passage and approval, otherwise it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
