Minutes for the Village of Beverly
2022 Budget Public Hearing
Wednesday, July 14, 2021

- The Village of Beverly 2022 Budget Public Hearing was called to order by Mayor Jim Ullman on Wednesday, July 14, 2021 at 6:30 PM. Council members present were Jay Arnold, Kandy Baker, Rollin Hopkins, Derrick Huck, Abigail Spung, and Edgar Kegley. Also present was Fiscal Officer Pamela Jackson.
- Jackson presented the 2022 Budget. The budget is mandated by Washington County and is reviewed by the Washington County Budget Commission made up by the Washington County Auditor, Treasurer, and Prosecuting Attorney. The Village has received 3.4 of the outside 10 mil limitation for many years. Projected property tax revenues are based on the County Auditor's estimated municipal tax valuation of general property tax. The estimated property tax valuation for 2022 is \$20,651,130.
- Council members reviewed the proposed 2022 Budget as presented. The budget reflects the use of funds received by the county and state. Historical data and estimates for projected projects are used to create the budget.
- With no further discussion, the hearing adjourned at 7:00 PM. Council will take action on the 2022 Budget at the regular Council meeting, July 14, 2021, 7:00 PM.
